

Rationale

The Government of India announced the National Education Policy-2020 in July 2020 covering all levels of education – from school education to higher education, including professional and adult education – the policy rests on the principles of affordability, accessibility, quality, equity, and accountability. A substantial part of the policy document is devoted to higher education, with emphasis on multidisciplinary approach, faculty and institutional autonomy, governance reforms, enhancing access through credit mobility, open and digital learning environment, and skills development. Therefore, in order to achieve the goals of National Education Policy vis a vis Higher Education, various strategies need to be implemented as follows: 1. Robust education system and research facility to compete with global standards 2. Provision of multiple entry and multiple exit at higher level of education 3. Establishment of academic bank of credit in which credits earned by the students during their academics from different HEIs could be stored and transferred at the time of final degree.
